Commander Eithu Lwin is currently serving as the Policy Analyst and Regulatory Counsel in the Division of Regulatory Policy (DRP), Office of New Drug Policy (ONDP), leading the regulatory review and clearance of 505(b)(2) applications for all 27 distinct medical divisions within Office of New Drugs (OND). She has served as the Clinical Policy Program Coordinator in ONDP where she led workgroups that wrote and published three guidances on COVID-19 therapeutics as part of FDA's international response to the pandemic. She has completed a 6-month detail assignment as the Drug Shortage Officer where she prevented, mitigated, and resolved critical national drug shortages in support of relief operations for major Hurricanes Harvey, Irma, and Maria. She has also served as the Senior Regulatory Project Manager in the Division of Transplant and Ophthalmology Products, where she led multidisciplinary review teams and oversaw administrative and regulatory review processes of drug and biological product applications longitudinally throughout its drug development. Prior to joining the FDA, CDR Lwin served as the clinical pharmacist at an isolated hardship Indian Health Service in Chinle, Arizona. She received her Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) from the Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences (MCPHS) University in Boston, Massachusetts in 2011. She completed Juris Doctor (J.D.) degree at the University of Maryland Francis King Carey School of Law in Baltimore, Maryland in 2021.
