CDR Quynh-Van Tran is a team leader in the Good Clinical Practice Compliance Oversight Branch in the Office of Scientific Investigations. She leads a team of reviewers whose primary responsibilities are to evaluate complaints regarding clinical investigators, sponsors, and contract research organizations and issue for-cause inspection assignments, issue routine surveillance inspection assignments for institutional review boards, review establishment inspection reports, and provide written post-inspectional correspondences to the inspected party. She works with the field investigators in the Office of Regulatory Affairs during the inspection and participates in inspections for high-profile cases as a Subject Matter Expert. CDR Tran received her Bachelor of Arts degrees in biology and psychology from the University of Virginia and her Doctor of Pharmacy degree from Virginia Commonwealth University/ Medical College of Virginia. She also completed a residency in Psychiatric Pharmacy Practice from University of Maryland, School of Pharmacy. She joined the FDA in 2010 as a regulatory review officer in the Office of Prescription Drug Promotion and was commissioned in 2012.

CDR Tran previously served as DC COA President-Elect (2019-2020), DC COA Treasurer (2014-2016) and DC COA Finance Chair (2013-2014). In addition to her role in DC COA, she serves as the Resource Coordination Branch Chief on the Tier 1 deployment team (RIST-NCR) and participated in 6 deployments to support USPHS mission: Ebola (2015); Peace Officer Memorial (2017); Independent Day Celebration (2017); and Hurricane Harvey and Irma (2017), State of the Union (2018) and United Nations General Assembly (2019).
